



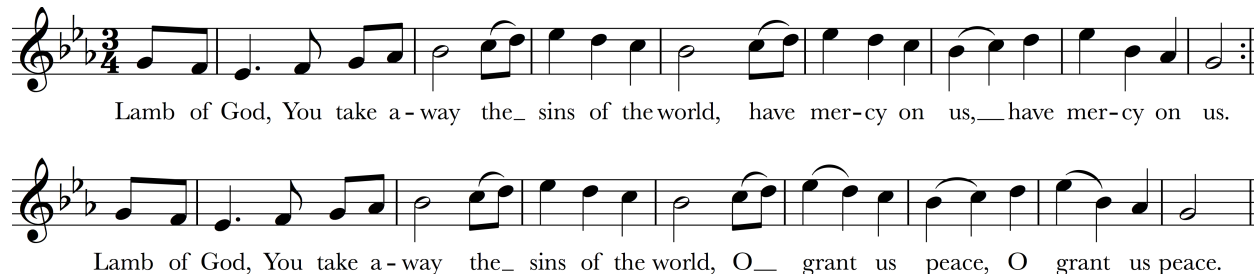

Communion
